# 松戸南部市場 About us

Matsudo Nanbu Ichiba (The Matsudo Nanbu Wholesale Market) was launched in 1966 as the first, large privately-run wholesale market in the Tokyo Metropolitan Area. It has since continued to evolve significantly, along with the robust growth of Matsudo City and its vicinities. It supplies a wide range of products -- fisheries, groceries, processed foods, flowers and plants -- to about 5 million consumers in Chiba Prefecture's northwestern Tokatsu area, Tokyo's Edogawa, Katsushika and Adachi Wards as well as some parts of Saitama Prefecture.

The Matsudo Nanbu Wholesale Market, one of the largest wholesale markets in Chiba Prefecture, has also developed into a major logistics hub that caters to 5 million people in the Tokyo Metropolitan Area. Its facilities have been improved to keep the freshness of products – fish, fruit and vegetables, meat, fresh flowers and others – for delivery. As such, it is expected to grow further as a comprehensive wholesale market, going forward.

The Matsudo Nanbu Wholesale Market was renovated in 2007 and is operated by Ichigo Marché Co., Ltd.

 Matsu 3 for New Tokyo Hospital

 Get off at Sogo Ichiba Mae (3-min walk) or Fujimidai (5-min walk)

### 1) Lottery

### 3) Cross-bow game

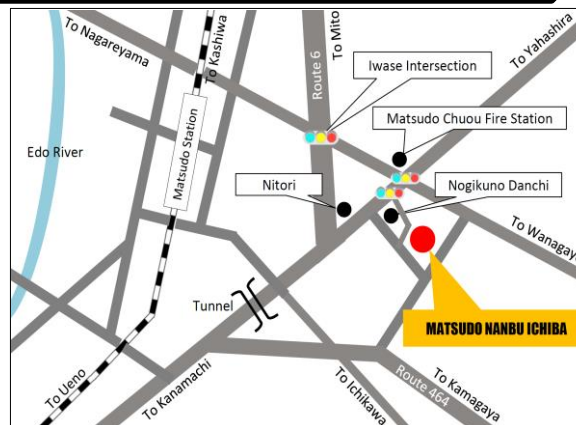
- Starting at 10:00 a.m. on every 3rd Monday

- \* 09:30 a.m. at Sengyokan every Saturday
- \* 10:00 a.m. at Fukuei Shoji every Saturday
- \* Sale of tuna after the cutting performance

- Starting at 10:00 a.m. every 3rd Wednesday
- \* Capacity: 40 people
- \* Registration ends when all spaces are filled.
